

# Ground Transportation to the Walnut Creek Marriott

## ◆ BART (Bay Area Rapid Transit) ◆

Hours of operation:

Monday through Friday 4:00 AM - Midnight

Saturday 6:00 AM - Midnight

Sunday 8:00 AM - Midnight

### **From San Francisco International Airport:**

The BART Station is located in the International Terminal. There's a free AirTrain to the BART Station from Terminals 1, 2, and 3.

Take the Pittsburg/Bay Point train, and exit at the Walnut Creek BART Station.

### **From Oakland International Airport:**

Take the AirBART shuttle service to the Coliseum BART station.

At the Coliseum Station take the Richmond train.

Transfer at the Oakland City Center/12th Street station to the Pittsburg/Bay Point train.

Exit at the Walnut Creek BART Station.

If you need the hotel shuttle to pick you up at the Walnut Creek BART station and bring you to the hotel, call our Bell Desk when you arrive, at 925-934-2000.

# Directions to the Walnut Creek Marriott

## Driving From San Francisco:

Take US 101 to I-80 East "Sacramento" and cross the Bay Bridge.  
Get into the right lanes and merge onto I-580 East "Oakland/Walnut Creek".  
After one mile merge onto Highway 24 "Walnut Creek".  
Drive east on Highway 24, through the Caldecott Tunnel, to the I-680 Interchange.  
Merge onto I-680 North "Concord/Sacramento".  
Quickly get into the right lane and take the North Main Street exit.  
Turn left on North Main Street and right at the next block—Parkside Drive.  
The hotel is located on the corner of North Main Street and Parkside Drive.

## Driving From Oakland:

Follow signs to I-880 North (Downtown Oakland).  
Take I-880 to I-980 "Walnut Creek". This turns into Highway 24.  
Drive East on Highway 24, through the Caldecott Tunnel, to the I-680 Interchange.  
Merge onto I-680 North "Concord/Sacramento".  
Quickly get into the right lane and take the North Main Street exit.  
Turn left on North Main Street and right at the next block—Parkside Drive.  
The hotel is located on the corner of North Main Street and Parkside Drive.

## Driving From Sacramento:

Follow signs to I-80 West "San Francisco".  
Merge onto I-680 "Concord/Walnut Creek".  
Cross the Benicia Bridge and proceed to Walnut Creek, exiting at North Main Street (South).  
The hotel is located on the corner of North Main Street and Parkside Drive.

## Driving From San Jose:

Follow signs to I-680 to Walnut Creek.  
Exit at North Main Street, just past the interchange with Highway 24.  
Turn left on North Main Street.  
The hotel is located on the corner of North Main Street and Parkside Drive.

## Convenient Location

- ◆ Walnut Creek is centrally located in Contra Costa County, convenient to Concord, San Ramon, Lafayette and Pleasant Hill; as well as Oakland, Berkeley and San Francisco.
- ◆ Walking distance from the Walnut Creek BART Station, which provides train service throughout the Bay Area.
- ◆ The Walnut Creek Marriott is located at the intersection of North Main Street and Parkside Drive. It can be easily accessed from I-680 Freeway or Highway 24 by taking the North Main Street exit.
