Tricks, Traps & Ploys of CPM Scheduling (What Owners Need to Know about CPM Scheduling)

This workshop will focus on what Owner's Facilities/Construction Management personnel should look for in the Baseline CPM schedule from their contractors on the Owner's construction projects.
