## **2018 NorCal Construction Management Scholarship Program**

The Construction Management Association of America, Northern California Chapter (CMAA NorCal Chapter) is pleased to announce our 2018 Scholarship Program. This program was created in accordance with our Chapter Bylaws and our mission to promote excellence and professionalism in Construction Management (CM). We hope to have another year of outstanding applicants and give recognition to those students that demonstrate exceptional scholastic achievement and promise as future CM practitioners.

### **PURPOSE**

---

The program is designed to recognize and provide financial assistance to Northern California area college students enrolled in undergraduate and graduate level CM programs.

---

### **APPLICATION, CRITERIA AND EVALUATION**

---

- \$11,000 will be awarded through five (5) individual scholarships. One (1) at \$4,000, one (1) at \$3,000, one (1) at \$2,000, two (2) at \$1,000.
- The top two scholarship recipients will also be awarded a guaranteed internship with their choice of one of the participating companies: Kitchell, AECOM, Swinerton Management or Vanir. The \$4,000 winner will have first choice and the \$3,000 will have second choice.
- The competition is open to students enrolled in CM programs at Stanford, UC Berkeley, Sacramento State, Chico State, Fresno State, Cal Poly (SLO) State University, San Jose State, and CSU East Bay.
- Students interested in being considered for a scholarship need to complete the 2018 Scholarship Application Package Application that is available on the NorCal Chapter website. The application form can be found at <http://www.cmaanorcal.org/>.
- Each application will be evaluated and awarded in accordance with the criteria stated in the application.
- Applications are due by March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018 @ 5:00 PM.
- NOTE: Scholarship recipients must be available to attend the 2018 Scholarships/Awards Banquet to be held on May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018 in San Francisco, CA.
